#### **Townhome(B)**

Lot Dimensions: 30-36' x 120-145'  
Primary Dwelling: Minimum 700 SF Footprint

#### **Bungalow Court (BC)**

Lot Dimensions: Dependent Upon Plan  
Primary Dwelling: No Minimum

#### **Cottage (C1)**

Lot Dimensions: 35-50' x 120-130'  
Primary Dwelling: Minimum 700 SF Footprint

#### **Village (C2)**

Lot Dimensions: 45-60' x 105-135'  
Primary Dwelling: Minimum 900 SF Footprint

#### **Neighborhood (D1)**

Lot Dimensions: 55-75' x 110-135'  
Primary Dwelling: Minimum 1200 SF Footprint

#### **Large Neighborhood (D2)**

Lot Dimensions: 70-85' x 110-130'  
Primary Dwelling: Minimum 1500 SF Footprint

#### **Manor/Mansion (E)**

Lot Dimensions: 80-110' x 110-200'  
Primary Dwelling: 2000-2500 SF Footprint

Building your home in Village Gardens is a unique experience. Benefits include:

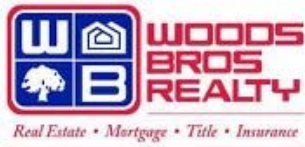
- An stylish and innovative Plan Library, giving you a foundation upon which you can design your dream
